1. General provisions

This Policy explains cookies and similar technologies used on <https://moscow2026.padelrus.ru>. The website is controlled by All-Russian Public Organization “Russian Padel Federation”. This English version is provided for convenience; the Russian version prevails in case of inconsistency.

A cookie is a small data file stored by a browser on a user’s device. Some cookies are necessary for the website, while others support audience analytics with the user’s consent.

2. Cookie categories

2.1. Necessary

Tilda uses these cookies to load pages, operate forms, provide security, maintain technical session state and remember the cookie-banner choice. Some website functions may fail without them.

2.2. Functional

These cookies may remember the selected language and other interface preferences where implemented.

2.3. Analytics

With consent, Yandex Metrica may be used to understand website traffic and improve the website. It may process IP address, cookie identifiers, browser and device data, referral source, viewed pages and website actions. Google Analytics is not used.

2.4. Embedded content and form protection

The website may use Yandex services such as maps and SmartCaptcha and Russian video-hosting services. These providers may set their own necessary cookies when the relevant component loads.

3. Legal basis

Necessary cookies support website operation and security. Analytics and other optional cookies are used only after the user’s choice in the cookie banner.

4. Consent controls

Users can accept or refuse analytics cookies in the banner. Refusal does not restrict access to the main website content. The choice may be reset by deleting website cookies in browser settings and revisiting the website or through any cookie-settings interface provided on the website.

5. Retention

Session cookies are removed after the browser closes. Persistent cookies remain for the period set by the provider or until deleted by the user. Names and periods may change when Tilda and Yandex services are updated.

6. Browser controls

Users may restrict or delete cookies in browser settings. Blocking necessary cookies may affect forms, language settings and other functions.

7. Technical-data recipients

Technical data may be processed by Tilda and Yandex when providing platform, analytics, map, email and security services. Google services are not used for analytics or forms.
