

Personal Data Processing Policy

1. General provisions

This Policy describes how All-Russian Public Organization “Russian Padel Federation” (the “Controller”) processes and protects personal data obtained through <https://moscow2026.padelrus.ru>, its English version, tournament registration forms and related information services.

This Policy is governed by Federal Law No. 152-FZ On Personal Data dated 27 July 2006 and other applicable laws of the Russian Federation. This English version is provided for convenience; if it differs from the Russian version, the Russian version prevails.

2. Controller details

3. Data subjects and data categories

The Controller processes data of website visitors and adult tournament participants.

3.1. Participant data

- first and last name; gender/tournament category; citizenship and, if applicable, second citizenship; represented country; date of birth;
- email address, phone number, preferred communication method and the contact identifier provided for a messenger or social network;
- FIP ranking position, if any; partner’s name and represented country;
- whether assistance with a Russian visa is required;
- technical submission data such as date and time, IP address, browser and device information where logged by the platform.

Each player completes and confirms a separate application. Partner details are used only to match individual applications and form a pair.

3.2. Website visitor data

The website may process IP address, cookies, browser and device information, referral source, viewed pages, website actions and language preference. Further details appear in the Cookie Policy.

4. Purposes

- registering and admitting players to the Moscow 2026 International Padel Tournament;
- communicating with participants and providing visa support directly through the Russian Padel Federation;

- reviewing applications and forming participant lists, pairs and draws;
- maintaining ranking and match-result information;
- publishing approved data, photographs and video under a separate dissemination consent;
- audience analytics and website operation and security;
- compliance with law and responses to lawful government requests.

5. Legal grounds

Processing is based on the data subject's consent, a separate consent to disseminate personal data, steps requested by the participant in connection with the application, and applicable Russian law.

6. Processing operations

The Controller may collect, record, organise, accumulate, store, update, retrieve, use, transfer in the cases described here, provide access, disseminate under a separate consent, anonymise, block, delete and destroy personal data, by automated and non-automated means.

7. Storage, localisation and retention

Tilda CRM configured for users in the Russian Federation is the main application storage system. Yandex email is used for operational correspondence. The Controller does not use Google Analytics, Google Sheets or other Google services for application processing or website analytics.

Application data is retained in Tilda CRM until 25 October 2027, one year after the tournament ends on 25 October 2026, unless a longer period is required by law or to resolve a dispute. Data is then deleted from operational systems and email and removed from backups after the applicable technical backup cycle.

8. Recipients and disclosure

Access is limited to authorised Federation employees. To the extent necessary, data may be provided to tournament organisers, the sports venue and processors acting on the Controller's instructions, and to public authorities upon a lawful request. Visa support is provided by the Federation itself. The website does not collect medical information and does not disclose data to medical organisations.

Tilda processes data as a processor supporting the Controller's use of the platform. The Controller does not intentionally arrange cross-border transfers through the website tools.

9. Public dissemination

Under a separate consent, the Controller may publish the participant's name, country, ranking position, tournament category, partner, match results, photographs and video on the website, in media and on social networks. Contact details, date of birth, second citizenship, communication preferences and visa-support information are not published.

10. Cookies and analytics

The website uses necessary Tilda cookies and, with the user's consent, Yandex analytics technologies. Optional analytics cookies should not be set before the user's choice. They may be refused through the cookie banner. See the Cookie Policy for details.

11. Security

The Controller applies legal, organisational and technical safeguards, including role-based access, individual accounts, employee access controls, encrypted connections, backups, incident handling and scheduled deletion.

12. Data subject rights

A data subject may request information, correction, restriction or deletion and may withdraw consent or challenge the Controller's actions by writing to media@padelrus.ru. Identity verification information may be requested.

13. Final provisions

The Controller may update this Policy when the law, services or processing change. The current version is published on the website. Russian law governs this Policy.
